- The competition is the third round of the 2019 Czech-Slovak Para Swimming Cup
- The competition is open to swimmers with physical, mental, and visual impairments from Slovakia and abroad
- The competition is approved by World Para Swimming and allows to meet the limits of the European Championships 2020 and the Paralympic Games 2020
- The event is held under the auspices of the Chairman of the Bratislava Self-Governing Region, Mgr. Juraj Droba, MBA, MA and the Mayor of the City of Bratislava, Ing. arch. Matúš Vallo

Part I. General Information

The Slovak Republic Para Swimming Championships follow the successful series of the 32nd annual SLOVAKIA CUP, whose last year at a 50m pool was in 2011. In the period 2012 to 2018 it was held at a 25m pool. After last year's competition, the Bratislava Grand Prix, and the creation of a series of Czech-Slovak Cup races, organised by the Czech Union of Physically Disabled Athletes and the Slovak Paralympic Committee in the Czech and Slovak Republics, we are once again returning to a 50m swimming pool.

Changes will be finalised on Wednesday 16.10.2019 at 12:00. After this date, the starting lists will be created.

Entry fee and payment: **The entry fee of EUR 35 / person** is the same for all participants. The entry fee includes a race (swimmer or personal), meal (Saturday lunch package), gift bag and t-shirt, transportation on the competition day (from accommodation to the pool and back).

Accommodation: EUR 25 / person per night (the price is subsidised)

The sending entity will pay the invoice issued according to the number of participants in the event. **Fees must be paid to the Organizer upon arrival at the competition.**

Part II. Technical Information

Regulation:	<p>Competition for class S1-14 swimmers at the 50m pool with electronic timekeeping according to valid international rules of World Para Swimming, STC swimming regulation for Czech-Slovak Cup 2019 and according to these propositions.</p> <p>On Thursday 17.10.2019, the primary start list for the participating clubs will be generated. After this date and time, it will no longer be possible to add or remove individual disciplines, it will not be possible to register new swimmers, it will only be possible to approve swimmers from all of the races.</p> <p>We will withdraw cancelled swimmers from the final start list; the start list will not be drawn up again, heats and lanes will remain the same as in the primary start list.</p>
Competition system and announcement:	<p>One competition day, two blocks, heats on time, ranking in each discipline according to German Paralympic Swimming point calculation, all classification classes and all ages together, men and women separately.</p> <p>One swimmer may have a maximum of 4 individual starts (two in each competition block)</p> <p>The first three places in each individual discipline will be awarded a medal and a diploma. The announcement will be made at the pool after the end of each block.</p> <p>Team competition takes place according to ČSP 2019 regulation, including relays. Relay reports must be submitted to the race director on the appropriate form at least one hour before the start of the race block. Relays can be freely mixed, regardless of gender and age, of swimmers with one club membership to at least NN status (up to 20 and 34 points respectively).</p> <p>Clubs can put together more than one relay team, the organiser reserves the right to limit the number of relays.</p> <p>As part of a ceremonial dinner for swimmers in the Czech-Slovak Cup, the results will be announced according to the Czech-Slovak Cup 2019 competition regulations.</p>
Classification:	<p>Proper classification (international or national) is a prerequisite for inclusion in a race</p>
Restrictions:	<p>The organiser reserves the right to limit the number of starting competitors so that the programme finishes on time according to the race schedule.</p>
Protests:	<p>The team leader must file protests only to referees, which are written on a World Para Swimming protest form, within 30 minutes after the official results have been released, together with a EUR 20 deposit. If the Protest is upheld, the deposit will be refunded. If the protest is rejected, the deposit remains with the organiser.</p>
Health care:	<p>Health care will be provided throughout the competition. Team leaders are responsible for the health of their team members and must report all relevant health information during the technical meeting.</p>
Insurance:	<p>Each NPC or sport club must ensure that all members of their delegation are appropriately insured, including coverage for travel, liability, accidents and repatriation. All delegation members must have appropriate accident and health insurance accepted in order to compete. At the venue only provide basic medical services.</p>

No medical insurance will be provided to any of the participants. All participants are responsible for obtaining their own medical insurance (including Repatriation Coverage) and will be responsible for any medical expenses resulting from participation in the event.

Anti-Doping:

As a condition of entry, competitors agree if selected for testing to submit to Doping Control under the jurisdiction of the Slovak Anti-Doping Agency (SADA).

It is the responsibility of each athlete to comply with the Anti-Doping Rules of SADA while at this event. In addition, it is the responsibility of each athlete to submit to Doping Control at this event if selected for testing.

Results management for any Anti-Doping Rule Violation will remain the responsibility of the applicable National Federation.
